PART 1 - A short film

- **Title:** Take Care (tentative)
- **Duration:** 30 mins
- **Logline:** A divorced home-care nurse has to return to her family, who she defied for love, after being fired abruptly from a job.
- **Tone:** An intimate, tense character-driven story set over 3 days

What you are funding

PART 2 - Collectivisation

In preparation for the film, we conducted a research study which consisted of in-depth interviews of multiple home-care nurses, doctors, elderly patients and their caretakers, and desk-based research.

The study led us to the conclusion that most home-care nurses face issues of personal safety in workplaces, they have to deal with predatory agencies, they lack representation: most of them are not accepted into nursing unions, and are unable to even think of a better future.

We decided that another outcome of this project would be to create an informal network of Home-care nurses, to foster solidarity and support, and hopefully creating scope for collective action.

What is the thought behind

As India's demographic gets older, elderly care becomes a problem of increasing importance. With the western solution of senior care facilities not seen a feasible solution in a family-oriented society such as ours, we found it interesting to explore the questions: how elderly care is valued in the country, who does the work, and what are the conditions of the work.

The film aims to explore both the conditions of growing old, and what it means to take care of someone.

What is the plan

Although the duration aimed at is longer than the average short film, we plan to achieve it by keeping the crew and cast small, and restricting the story to 2-3 locations.

Our approach to production will be to keep the technicalities at a minimum and let the story tell itself in a clear manner.
